## A Local Organization Helping Local Classrooms

“Crayons to Classrooms began in early 2008 as a community initiative to provide free educational supplies, such as paper, pencils and notebooks, to qualifying teachers for students in need. To participate, teachers must be from schools that are pre-registered with Crayons to Classrooms, the criterion being that at least 70 percent of the school’s students participate in the National School Lunch Program. In the Greater Dayton Region, there are approximately 88 schools and 1700 teachers who are serving the educational needs of 26,000 children that qualify. Since opening their doors January 15, 2009, Crayons to Classrooms has distributed useful classroom materials worth over \$520,000 to teachers educating low-income children.
